Student Travel Awards

The Center of Excellence in Cancer Research and Therapeutic Development (CCRTD) at Clark Atlanta University will provide 2 travel awards of \$500 to selected student participants. Awards will be made to participants traveling to Atlanta from external cities to attend the Symposium. Students competing for travel awards must submit their abstracts by February 6, 2009. These funds may only be used to supplement air travel and/or hotel costs for attending the Symposium. The selected students will give oral presentations in the “Student Symposium Presentations” session to be held on March 16, 2009.

Student Poster Competition

The Symposium will feature a national student poster competition with prizes awarded to undergraduate and graduate students presenting research in biomedical sciences. Undergraduate and graduate students from all institutions are invited to present their research findings and compete for these prizes.
